STATEMENT: NIAP CCEVS agrees with the contents of the Dedicated Security Components Essential Security Requirements (ESR), version 1.0, dated 5 April 2016.

PURPOSE: The intent of this Position Statement is to make it publicly known that NIAP CCEVS:

- recognizes a need for evaluated devices that are suitable for the use cases identified in the ESR, and;
- the ESR appropriately scopes the security functionality of such devices.

SCOPE: NIAP CCEVS will revisit its position during each stage of the Dedicated Security Components collaborative Protection Profile (cPP) development.

If NIAP CCEVS endorses the resulting Dedicated Security Components cPP, products evaluated against the cPP that demonstrate exact conformance to the cPP will be placed on the NIAP CCEVS Product Compliant List: https://www.niap-ccevs.org/CCEVS_Products/pcl.cfm
