Full Disk Encryption - Essential Security Requirements (ESR) version 0.2 dated 1 May 2014

The CSE Common Criteria (CC) certification authority supports the *Full Disk Encryption* Essential Security Requirements (ESR), version 0.2, dated 1 May 2014. We believe that the identified use cases and the scope of the security functionality are appropriate for this class of devices.

CSE reserves the right to revisit our position at any stage throughout the development of the *Full Disk Encryption* collaborative Protection Profile (cPP).

Should the resulting cPP meet the intent of the ESR, CSE will endorse the use of it to conduct product evaluations within the Canadian CC scheme.
