STATEMENT: NIAP endorses the Dedicated Security Components (DSC) collaborative Protection Profile (cPP) Version 1.0, dated 10 September 2020. NIAP anticipates the iTC will establish an interpretations team responsible for providing timely responses to requests for interpretation of this cPP and Supporting Document (SD).

With this endorsement, products successfully evaluated against the DSC cPP that demonstrate exact conformance to the cPP, and in compliance with all NIAP policies, will be placed on the NIAP Product Compliant List: <https://www.niap-ccevs.org/Product>

PURPOSE: The intent of this Endorsement Statement is to make it publicly known that NIAP CCEVS:

- recognizes a need for evaluated devices that are suitable for the use cases identified in the DSC cPP;
- considers the Security Problem Definition and resulting Security Functional Requirements appropriate for the intended use cases; and,
- believes the DSC cPP's companion Supporting Document (SD) specifies objective, repeatable Evaluation Activities that are appropriate for the intended environment, and will produce comparable results.

SCOPE: NIAP will revisit its endorsement during each release of the DSC cPP and SD. If NIAP continues to endorse subsequent releases of the DSC cPP, an updated Endorsement Statement will be published.
