



Canadian Common Criteria Program Endorsement Statement

Collaborative Protection Profile for Hardcopy Devices v1.0

7 February 2023

1. The Certification Body for the Canadian Common Criteria Program formally endorses the *Collaborative Protection Profile for Hardcopy Devices (HCDcPP)* version 1.0, dated 31 October 2022.
2. The Certification Body recognizes a need for evaluated products that are suitable for the use cases identified in the HCDcPP and considers the Security Problem Definition and Security Functional Requirements appropriate for the intended use cases.
3. The Canadian Common Criteria Program will certify products against the requirements of the HCDcPP, and products that comply with recognized Protection Profiles are recommended for deployment within government and critical infrastructure sectors.
4. The Certification Body will revisit its endorsement during each subsequent release of the HCDcPP and its Supporting Document. If the Certification Body continues to endorse subsequent releases of the HCDcPP and its Supporting Document, an updated Endorsement Statement will be published.
