# Strategic Intent

  - **Develop IT security capabilities and measures for business continuity readiness**
    - **Participant of Common Criteria Recognition Arrangement (started Mar 05)**
    - **Singapore Common Criteria evaluation & certification Scheme**
      - **Certification Body function under the Info-communications Development Authority of Singapore (started May 07)**
      - **Certificate Authorising status pursuit**
      - **Cost-effective and convenient means to obtain Common Criteria certification**

## > Light-touch two-prong approach

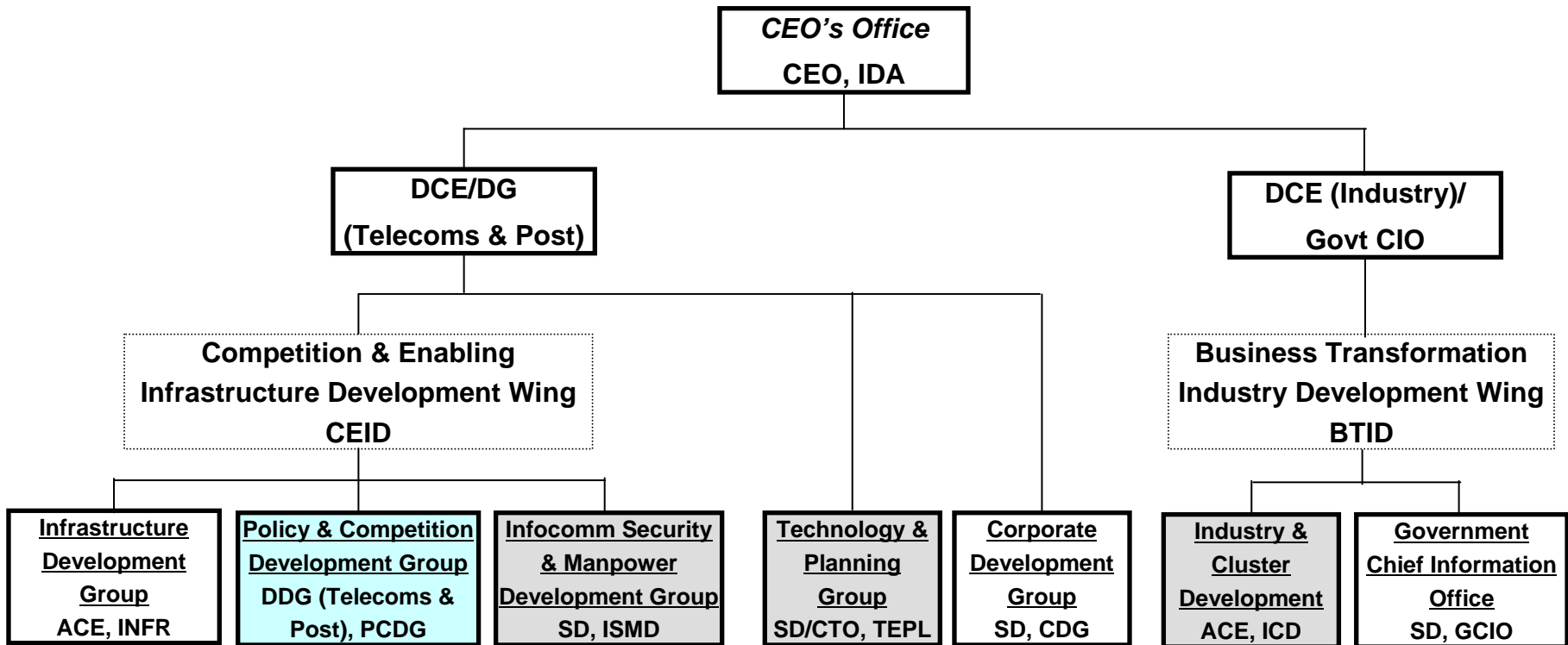
- Common Criteria awareness programme for IT product buyers in the public sector
- Preference for CC-certified products in Tender / Request for Proposal process



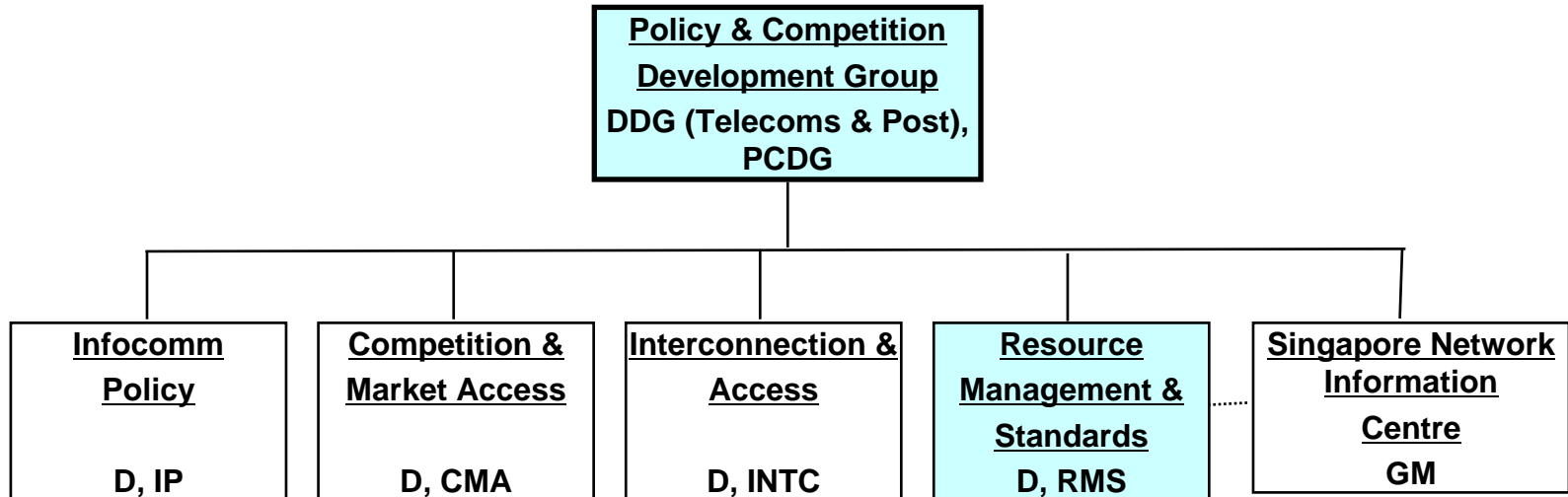

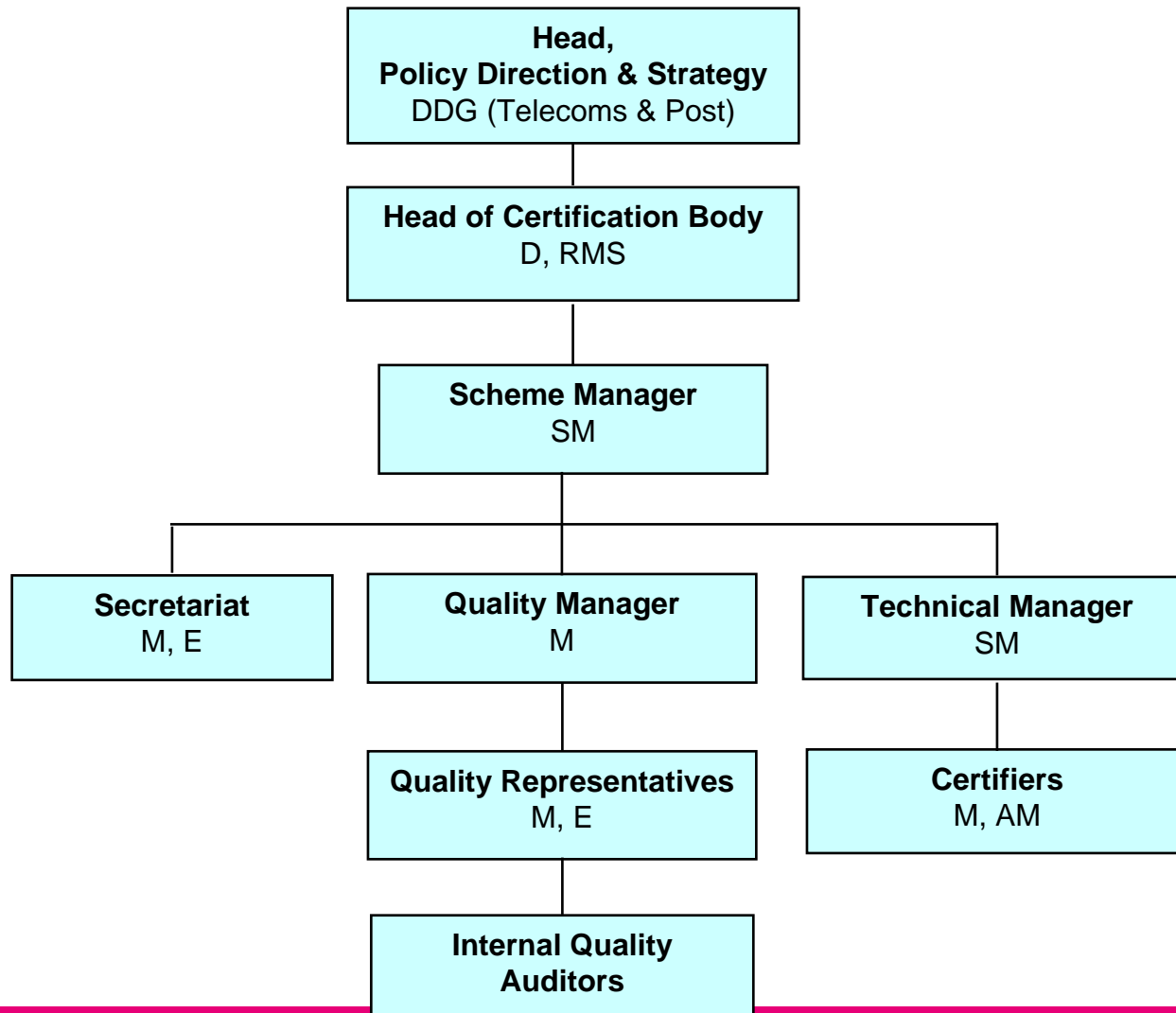
# IDA Corporate Organisation Chart



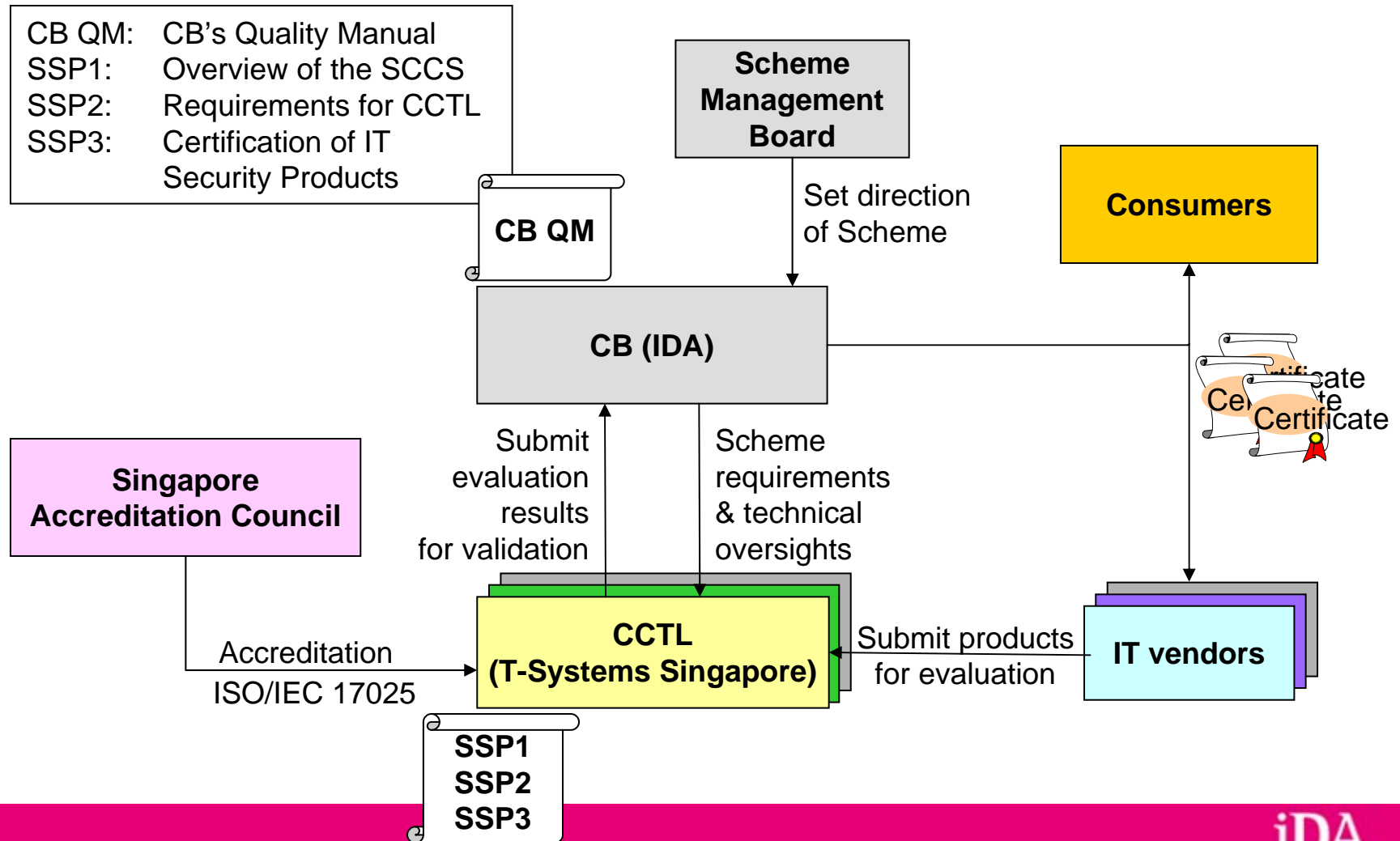
# IDA Policy & Competition Development Group Organisation Chart



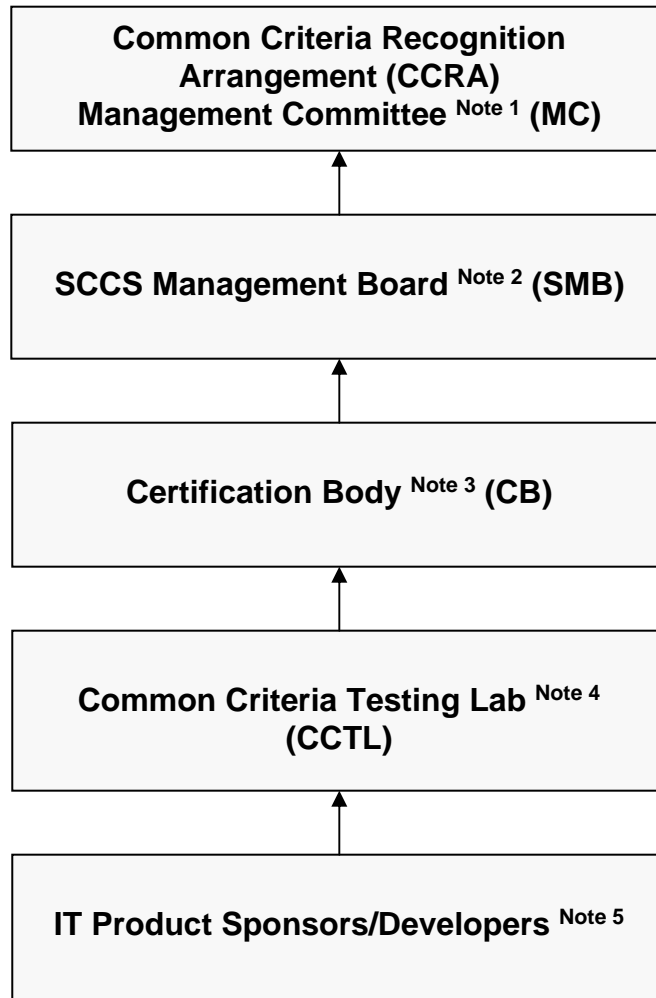
# Structure of the Certification Body

# Governance Structure of the Singapore Scheme



- Note 1: The MC represented by Certificate Issuing countries, oversees the CCRA internationally.
- Note 2: SMB comprises IDA (ISMD/ISTD, PCDG/RMS & TEPL), SPRING Singapore, DSO National Laboratories, Singapore Infocomm Technology Federation Security Chapter, and Security & Privacy Standards Technical Committee of the Information Technology Standards Committee. IDA (ISMD) chairs the SMB.
- Note 3: CB role is performed by IDA (RMS).
- Note 4: CCTL is approved by CB (IDA).
- Note 5: Sponsors pay for the evaluation and certification while developers are responsible for the design and implementation of the IT product.

- > Since 1997, the Singapore Accreditation Council has signed numerous multi-lateral Mutual Recognition Arrangements:
- Asia Pacific Laboratory Accreditation Cooperation for Testing, Calibration and Inspection
  - European Accreditation Cooperation for Testing and Calibration
  - International Accreditation Cooperation for Testing and Calibration
  - International Accreditation Forum for Quality Management System
  - Pacific Accreditation Cooperation for Quality Management System
